Gifts are sent directly to the national appeal for hunger relief in the world. The Evangelical Lutheran Church in America is a strong advocate and leader in the fight to abolish hunger globally and domestically.
Gifts are directed by the Global Missions Steering Committee to needy communities around the globe. They also may include our mission associations in India, Philippines and Tanzania.
Our goal is to build a long-term relationship between the youth of Bethel and the people of Antigua through the Escuela Integrada School.
Gifts specifically for India Mission, where in association with Bethania Kids, we care for orphans.
Gifts specifically for Philippines Mission, where Concordia Children's Services responds to the needs of abandoned and neglected babies and children in the metro Manila area.
Gifts specifically for Tanzania Mission, where we support Selian Lutheran Hospital, and the Massae Girls School, as well as financially supporting students seeking higher education.
The Congregational Community Action Project (CCAP) is our local faith-based relief organization which assists with food, clothing, utilities and other essentials for those in our community who are in extreme need.
Gifts designated support the enhancement of our Music Ministry (i.e., guest musicians, concerts and scholarships).
Established for Bethel college students to participate in at least one intensive immersion experience focused on Christian service.
Gifts given in memory of members and friends of Bethel who have died. Council approves the disbursement of this fund.
Payment for flower arrangements in recognition of a family's or individual's special occasion, anniversary, etc. This category is not deductible for IRS Federal Income Tax purposes.
Established by Council, this fund provides assistance to those with needs that sometimes cannot be met by organizations such as CCAP or the Salvation Army.
Gifts to this fund are designated to pay down Bethel's mortgage.
Used to accumulate funds for specifically designated special purposes during the year, normally one-time occurrences.
