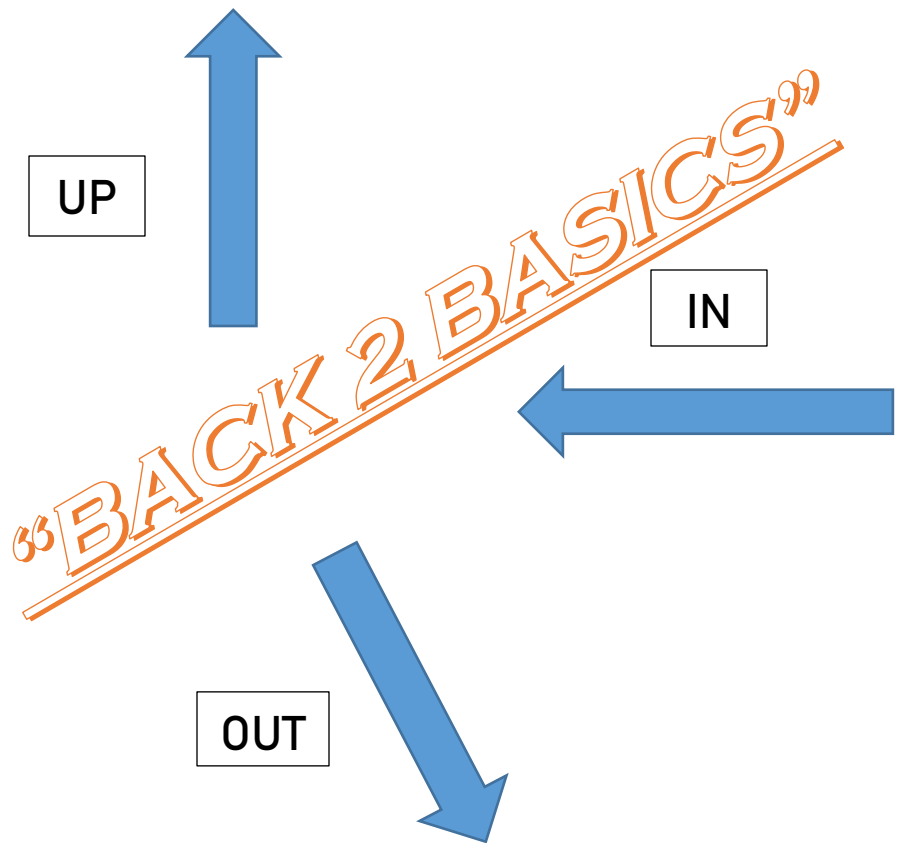

They are each responsible for the overall direction and coordination of their respective teams and activities.

This booklet contains descriptions of each team and activity. Carefully review them to determine those that interest you and then sign up!! Worship

051 Altar Care

Care for the altar linens, prepare and clean up for Holy Communion and Holy Baptism, and change altar paraments. Inventory and place order for supplies with the office for special services (i.e., Christmas Eve candles and ashes for use on Ash Wednesday) Training is provided.

053 Communion Bread Baking

Be a part of the team that bakes bread for communion. Training is provided.

056 After Worship Pick-Up

After worship, pick up and neaten the sanctuary area, then replenish visitor welcome cards and pew offering envelopes.

101 Children's Sermon

1st and 3rd Sundays of the month. Team members will share the Gospel with our children in a short, *four-minute* age-appropriate sermon.

104 Worship Bag Replacement

During worship, our younger children have an opportunity to become more actively engaged in Christ-centered activity with materials in our Children's Worship Bags. Reorganize and replenish the bags with materials provided.

111 Communion Assistant

Humbly serve as a host of the Lord's Supper by distributing bread and offering the chalice of wine to all those who seek the gifts of God. Training provided.

115 Ensemble

The Ensemble leads congregational singing and shares special music of many genres regularly in our weekly Sunday morning worship gatherings and occasionally participates in other special events. It sings for special services during the year [Ash Wednesday at 7:00 pm), Holy Week (Maundy Thursday and Good Friday at 7:00 pm) and Christmas Eve (7:00 p.m. Candlelight Service). This group is open to vocalists in High School through adults of all ability levels and no prior musical or vocal training is required.

119 Instrumentalists

At times throughout the year, special musicians are called upon to share their gift of music in various ways. Opportunities include orchestra and smaller instrument ensembles, as well as solo musicians. This ministry opportunity is open to instrumentalists of all ages and all instruments. While there is no formal audition required for participation, musicians should have at least one year of private study on their instrument and should be able to read music at a high school to college level of difficulty.

121 Greeter

Hospitality is the gift used to welcome all to our community as we gather to worship and praise Jesus Christ on Sunday mornings. Greet folks at the doors or give them a bulletin as they enter the sanctuary and say, "Good morning, welcome to Bethel." Greeters are expected to arrive thirty minutes prior to worship and to remain in the narthex area to assist late arriving parishioners until after the first Scripture Reading is completed.

131 Nursery and Child Care

During Sunday morning worship service, child care is offered for families with infants and young children. Assist our attendant in caring for and watching our children in the nursery.

141 Prayer During Worship

Lead the congregation in prayer on Sunday mornings, including the Gathering Prayer. Guidelines are provided.

151 Scripture Reader

Every week we read from the Bible, using a passage or passages through which God can speak to the hearers. Pray before reading the text and humbly read the selected passage or passages with honor and respect. Guidelines are provided.

163 Christmas in a Barn

Bethel presently celebrates a special worship service on Christmas Eve in a barn on Christmas Eve afternoon. This is a centerpiece of our Advent celebration and draws large attendance from the Winchester/Frederick County area. Help with the planning, preparation and clean-up after the service.

171 Usher

Arrive at least thirty minutes prior to worship and assist families and individuals locate seats in the Sanctuary for worship. Fifteen minutes after the worship service begins, lock both exterior doors leading into the Narthex. One Usher remains in the narthex area to monitor the locked doors throughout the service to assist late arriving parishioners, except a) when collecting the Offering, b) when directing worship attendees who wish to receive Communion and c) following completion of worship, taking the offering and placing it in the 2nd drawer of the Staff Meeting Room safe. Complete training is provided. Because of the Safety and Security aspect of this position, *individuals should be at least eighteen years old.*

191 Sound Team

Each week, control the sound board during worship, operate microphones, assist with hearing aids, document worship attendance (including the Nursery) and record the service for posting on the website. Training is provided.

Learning

200 Advent Traditions

Help organize and order materials for this congregational activity of making wreaths and learning about the traditions of Advent and the Advent wreath.

210 Bible Study LEADERS

Pastor Dave is looking for individuals willing to lead time-limited Bible Studies for the congregation. You will work with Pastor Dave in designing the studies to meet your interests and confidence level.

220 Disciple Study LEADERS

Bethel offers the Disciple Bible Study each year. There are Disciple I, II, III and IV level courses. If you have completed any or all of these courses, you are invited to consider being a leader/convener for the courses you've completed.

250 Sunday School Team LEADER – September 2020

In looking forward to next year, provide a vital support role within the church in guiding Christian learning for deepening our faith and maturing in our spirituality. Lead the organizing, planning and implementation of the Bethel Sunday School Program.

251 Sunday School Steering Committee – September 2020

Provide ongoing assistance to the Sunday School Team LEADER in the organizing and planning of the Sunday School Program.

252 Sunday School Teacher – September 2020

Classes are normally co-taught with teacher teams. Sign-up if you have any interest! You will be contacted in early summer to determine if you are still interested and, if so, which ages you would prefer. Curriculum, training and support are provided.

253 Sunday School Substitute Teacher – September 2020

Be willing to cover a Sunday School class if a regular teacher is out for planned or unexcepted reasons. Classes are normally co-taught with teacher teams. Curriculum, training and support are provided. Feel free to sign up if you have any interest! You will be contacted on an as-needed basis and can determine at that time if you will be available for that particular week and class.

280 VBS DIRECTOR

Shapes the mission and direction of Vacation Bible School in providing oversight and guidance of teams and planning for our week with children, youth and families.

281 VBS Design Team

Be part of a team who builds, decorates and designs all the stations, stages and props for Vacation Bible School.

282 VBS Station LEADER

Co-Lead one of the station rotations for children during Vacation Bible School.

283 VBS Volunteer

Help during the week with a station, teaching, supplies or other needs.

Servant

301 Bright Futures

Help respond to the needs of children at local schools. Leader (Liaison) will communicate with Bright Futures to help Bethel organize to help schools and needs of children through giving of food and other basic needs.

305 God's Work Our Hands Day

Join in an ELCA-wide event in September in which we address the needs in our community with servant projects.

313 Follow the Leader Camp "Buddy"

At this camp, which is specifically designed and staffed by occupational therapists, be a student (grade nine or higher) "buddy" to a child with special needs.

331 Harvest Sunday Helper

This ministry seeks to share with our parish and community, the beauty and bounty of God's creation. Assist in selling produce and homemade goodies on Harvest Sunday to raise money for world hunger.

344 Hoe Down Helper

Our annual "Hoe Down" serves clients from the Northwestern Workshop, which provides employment opportunities for adults in our community who have special needs. Assist with cooking, hosting, music, set-up and clean-up.

352 Global Missions Steering Team

The Global Missions Steering Team oversees Bethel's involvement in missions beyond the borders of the United States. This activity serves and supports ministries in four different countries, including India, Tanzania, the Philippines and Guatemala. In India, in association with Bethania Kids, we care for orphans. In Tanzania, we support Anusha Lutheran Medical Center, Selian Lutheran Hospital and the Massae Girls School, as well as financially supporting students seeking higher education. In the Philippines, Concordia Children's Services responds to the needs of abandoned and neglected babies and children in the metro Manila area. It also offers a Street Crisis Intervention Program providing a Christian-based learning program for children. In Guatemala, our goal is to build a long-term relationship between the youth of Bethel and the people of Antigua through the Escuela Integrada School. During Advent, Global Missions offers an alternative giving program to assist in raising money to fund our missions. Members of the Steering Team plan and organize mission trips to the above countries.

360 Returning Thanks Team

Bethel offers a special service opportunity to "love our neighbor," called Returning Thanks, where we perform light yard work and other tasks for those in need. We typically offer these outings on Good Friday (March/April) and/or the Saturday before Thanksgiving (November).

395 WATTS Planning and Coordination

Winchester Area Temporary Thermal Shelter (WATTS) is a collaboration among local churches to provide shelter for homeless people during winter nights. Churches take turns hosting guests for a week, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

396 WATTS Onsite Volunteer

Activities include attendee intake, meal preparation, after dinner activities and/or staying overnight.

Congregational Life

402 Building Faith Boxes

Help in building Faith Boxes that are given to our children at Baptism, First Communion and/or Confirmation.

404 Coat Rack Coffee and Opening Building

Located in the Narthex, become a part of this Sunday *first-welcoming group*. Assist in making coffee (sometimes also serving snacks) and provide fellowship before worship as people arrive. It's a fun time and an opportunity to socially visit with other members and friends. *This team also unlocks the Narthex exterior doors at least one hour before the commencement of worship.* Training is provided.

408 Fat Tuesday Fiesta

Each year, this fun evening includes dancing, a King Cake, mask making, eating pancakes, sausage and bacon, together with Fat Tuesday games in Discipleship Hall. Assist in preparing the bacon, sausage and pancakes for this occasion, while also participating in all the activity and joyous laughter!!

410 Fellowship Team

Organizes and operates various fellowship activities throughout the year, including potluck gatherings which are strictly social and summer cookouts. Organize, operate and work to share the love of Christ among our community of faith.

415 Men's Steering Team

Be a part of the Steering Team, praying about, discerning, and discussing God's vision and mission for Men's Ministries at Bethel.

432 Receptions and Hospitality

Assist in providing or arranging for refreshments, brunch, or light meals for special occasions, such as First Communion, Confirmation, Graduate Recognition Sunday, New Members Sunday, Ministry Celebration Sunday and Congregational Meetings.

434 Shrimp Boil

Help take a lot of shrimp and boil it together with corn, sausage, potatoes, onions and seasonings. The result is our annual Shrimp Boil. A favorite gathering for years, there is no one who leaves the table being hungry.

440 Care Package Team

This is an important part of our ministry as a Beacon from Bethel to our young adults who are taking the leap to higher education, military service, or a new job out of the area and for many, the final step out of the nest. This team is a regular reminder that these young adults remain a part of our Bethel Family and community of faith. This team provides various contacts and care packages sent at different times during the year.

444 Youth and Family Ministries Team

For youth and adults, using their gifts to set long-term goals and make specific plans together, that will shape the future of Bethel's youth and family ministries. This team will normally gather once a month for dessert, prayer and action!

446 f³ Planning and Organization

Help plan monthly Faith, Fellowship and Fun gatherings for families with children through Grade 4.

451 Women's Ministries LEADER

Guide and coordinate applicable activities, while, together with others, praying, discerning, and discussing God's vision and mission for Women's Ministries at Bethel.

452 Women's Ministries Planning

Join the group that keeps the Women's Ministry ongoing with fresh ideas from year to year.

453 Women's Christmas Dinner Planning

Work with other women in planning the annual Christmas Dinner – a holiday feast, complete with a gift exchange.

455 Women's Retreat Planning

Assist in organizing the annual Women's Retreat, a two-day Christian prayerful get-away for women of all ages.

456 Yard Sale Committee

Assist in organizing, sorting donations and/or working on the day of the annual Bethel Yard Sale which is normally held in July.

Prayer and Care

505 Centering Prayer

A Centering Prayer learning group meets once a week in the Bethel Prayer Room. This group typically meets during the school year on a regular basis, taking the summers off.

511 Funeral Reception Preparation

Assist with dressing the tables, setting out food and beverages, then cleaning up afterwards.

512 Funeral Reception Side Dish

Prepare a side dish for Funeral Receptions.

521 Send Greeting Cards

Through sending cards, we are able to share a word of joy and/or hope with our brothers and sisters in Christ. Address envelopes and send Greeting Cards to members and friends of Bethel, letting them know that others are praying for them, to wish them get-well and/or to celebrate special accomplishments. Birthday cards are only sent to non-adults.

531 Health and Wellness Team

In an effort to be good stewards of our health, join in providing ways to take care of our bodies and minds both physically and spiritually. Assist with organizing athletic opportunities and seek to provide the congregation with information regarding healthy habits for daily living.

533 Intercessory Prayer

Meet together with others to pray over any prayer requests that have been submitted in the prayer boxes, or on the prayer wall. Individuals will also pray over prayer concerns as well. Join us as we offer the gift of prayer to those most in need!

535 Baby Blankets, Hats, Prayer Shawls and Scarves

Through knitting or crocheting, use your hands to reach out to those in our congregation and others, with comfort, solace and strength in times of need, with baby blankets, hats, prayer shawls and scarves. Extra prayer shawls are also often taken to Winchester Medical Center to distribute to those undergoing chemo treatments for warmth, baby blankets are given to the newly baptized, while hats and scarves are given to WATTS program attendees. As these items are received by each recipient, we are praying and hoping that they will be reminded of God's promise that he is always with us.

551 Quilting

Can you imagine putting your children to bed at night with no cover to keep them warm? Working with others, by cutting, knotting and sewing, make gifts that will provide comfort and warmth to folks across the seas. Lutheran World Relief knotted quilts are easy to assemble and there are ways to be involved even if an individual doesn't sew.

553 Shepherd/Mentor Team

Individuals on this team will ensure that *new* congregational friends and members feel welcome and connected to church life. Additionally, they will also reach out to *current* parishioners that have dropped in attendance to check in with them and determine their needs and/or concerns.

555 Shut-In Visitation Team

Working with Pastor Dave, bring Holy Communion to our home-bound members and friends. The expectation is that you will visit with the person to whom you are assigned at least once a month. No one will have more than two people assigned to them at any given time.

561 Welcome Basket Assembly

To show hospitality to guests who worship with us, design and assemble Welcome Baskets.

562 Welcome Basket Delivery

Assist in personally delivering Welcome Baskets to our visitors and telling them, "We're glad God brought you to Bethel."

Ministry Support

602 Property Upkeep

With the size of our facility and surrounding grounds, there is always required routine maintenance, as well as special projects that are required during the year. With the variety of tasks, all are welcome to assist in this very important ongoing activity. Use the general signup number (602), or choose your specific area of interest:

603 Furniture Set-Up/Take-Down

Whenever there is a large gathering or special event, assist in setting-up, moving and taking-down chairs and tables.

614 Weekly Offering Counter

Work in two-person teams to count Sunday offerings after worship service, assisting with or inputting contributions into Bethel's computer program. Then print weekly giving reports and fill out a bank deposit form. Complete training is provided. Normally, teams count approximately once a month.

620 Safety and Security Committee

This committee reports direct to Council. It is responsible for the ongoing assessment, evaluation, development, implementation and management of appropriate measures and policies that will ensure the highest level of safety and security that can be reasonably achieved, while carefully and deliberately also balancing the need for our openness as a church.

632 Closing Building

After completion of worship services, assist in closing and locking the facility on Sunday.
